

Sensoneo Launches DPP.GS: A Compliance Platform Built for the Digital Product Passport Era

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DPP.GS compliance platform helps companies navigate packaging, textiles, and electronics regulations, and prepare for the Digital Product Passport Era. The platform centralizes regulatory monitoring and compliance documentation as EU sustainability legislation intensifies across industries.

DPP.GS, a compliance platform operated by Sensoneo, has announced its official launch, offering sustainability and administrative teams a centralized solution to manage the growing complexity of EU product regulations. The platform covers four distinct EU compliance instruments — the Digital Product Passport, the Digital Label, the Battery Passport, and Sunrise 2027 — giving companies a single place to meet today's obligations and prepare for those ahead.

Under the EU's sustainability legislation, compliance obligations are broader than many organizations realize — and they frequently overlap. The **Digital Product Passport** applies to physical goods such as textiles and electronics and must accompany products across the supply chain. The **Digital Label**, mandated by the Packaging and Packaging Waste Regulation (PPWR), is required for any company that uses packaging — from cardboard boxes to plastic bottles and bags. The **Battery Passport** covers companies in the battery value chain. And **Sunrise 2027** introduces new customs and import compliance requirements. Crucially, these obligations often compound: a textile manufacturer, for example, must hold a Digital Passport for their products and a Digital Label for every type of packaging those products ship in. DPP.GS is built to manage all four in a single platform.

As EU sustainability legislation accelerates, companies across the packaging, textile, electronics, and battery sectors face mounting pressure to track regulatory changes, meet documentation requirements, and prepare for supply chain transparency obligations. DPP.GS responds to this challenge by consolidating compliance workflows into a single platform: monitoring legislative developments, alerting teams to upcoming obligations, and supporting the creation and storage of compliance documentation, including Declarations of Conformity.

"Regulatory complexity is only going to increase, and for many companies, the real risk isn't non-compliance itself, but simply not knowing what's coming and when. DPP.GS was built to change that. We wanted to give sustainability and operations teams a practical tool that handles today's requirements — whether that's a Digital Label on your packaging, a Battery Passport, or Sunrise 2027 customs obligations — while already laying the groundwork for the full Digital Product Passport rollout."
